PCC report

The serious state of disrepair of Barham Road, Trecwn was raised in a meeting held recently by Barham Road residents. This has caused serious flooding due to the poor upkeep of the road, and Sam Kurtz has spoken to Darren Thomas, Head of Highways for PCC, about the issues. Residents are paying the same council tax as other areas but the accountability for the repairs needed is a grey area due to being a private road owned by Manhattan Loft Corporation. Sam Kurtz will be meeting with the legal team at PCC and Edward Perkins, Chartered Surveyors. There have been issues of brown water in taps as Welsh Water is not involved with water supply, and sewerage under conservatories.

Reports in the papers state that council tax increases could be between 5-29% - final amount will be decided in a meeting in April.

Sam Kurtz is available to discuss these matters privately or at a Council meeting.
