Construction of a Wood-Fuelled Power Station to Generate Energy from Biomass (including demolition of existing buildings, fuel storage facility and reception buildings, associated infrastructure and landscaping/habitat creation) at the Former Royal Navy Armaments Depot, Trecwn, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire.

a) MATERNITY AND NEONATAL SERVICES

An information pack and leaflets regarding the changes to Maternity and Neonatal services in Glangwili and Withybush Hospitals has been received.

Women under midwifery led care can now choose to give birth in one of the new Midwife Led Units at either Withybush or Glangwili Hosiptals. Women requiring additional care during pregnancy, labour or birth will be advised to give birth in the Consultant Led Unit at Glangwili Hospital. Special care baby facilities will no longer be provided at Withybush.

B) People's Postcode Trust

An email has been received regarding the People's Postcode Trust - Small Grants.

The Trust aims to make the UK a better place for both people and nature. Grants range from £500 up to £5,000 in Wales. Registered charities, constituted voluntary and

community groups, Social enterprises Community interest companies (CIC) Not-for-profit organisations and Sports clubs are eligible to apply. All projects should provide assistance in one or more of the Trust's following fields of operation:

- Prevention of poverty; reduction of distress and suffering
- Advancement of health
- Advancement of citizenship or community development
- Advancement of public participation in sport
- Advancement of human rights, conflict resolution or reconciliation
- Advancement of environmental protection or improvement

Funding is available for projects of up to 6 months in length in Wales that positively impact their local community. Projects that are creative, far-reaching and will leave a long-term impact once completed stand the best chance of being successful.

C) Change Step

An email has been received from Kimberley Rowlands regarding Change Step.

Change Step is a CAIS led peer mentoring and advice service for military veterans and others with post traumatic stress disorder or probable substance misuse issues who want to make positive changes to their lives. Their mission is to provide a Peer Mentoring Service for military veterans

The service is delivered by veterans for veterans and aims to support those seeking help for problems encountered as a result of military or operational duty. The programme will offer peer support and training opportunities, as well as counselling and detoxification from drugs or alcohol where required.

Change Step aims to work collaboratively with statutory bodies and other relevant organisations to ensure an accessible and comprehensive framework by which to guide individuals towards the most appropriate service.

Change Step offers a contact point for veterans, family members, and carers and a Community-based peer mentoring scheme delivered by veterans for veterans.

D) Lottery Coastal Communities Fund

The following email has been received from Jeremy Martineau, Hon Sec. Chamber of Trade and Tourism, Fishguard and Goodwick:

I am writing to let you know, in your capacity as clerk to your council(s) that the application to the Coastal Communities Fund by Fishguard and Goodwick Chamber of Trade and Tourism, to develop and extend tourism in North Pembrokeshire, has passed the first stage and the final and second stage will be submitted by September 24th 2014.

I should also tell you that we are awaiting a definition of “coastal” from the CCF.

The initial application was supported by a wide range of organisations and agencies and we are now establishing the nature of the partnerships with them.

We have applied for the maximum grant of £300,000 over the 2 year period and, should this be awarded, the project will co-ordinate and promote a wide range of initiatives from St. Dogmael’s to St. David’s working with our partners and those involved in Tourism in the coastal region of North Pembrokeshire.

Should we be successful we very much hope we will have the opportunity to work together to increase tourism in the area and to extend the number of jobs associated with the industry.
