Cllr O James reported that the adult education provision was under review. It cost £250k but brought in £1m. PCC want to make it expenditure neutral. It promotes Welsh Assembly funded courses available locally.

In the Local Development Plan 90% of planning applications are delegated, with only 10% going before committee. PCC are within the top 6 councils in Wales in obtaining all the articles in the LDP which is quite some accolade for the authority. Re the secondary school reorganisation, this is ongoing. There is another meeting in October. The Fishguard and Dewi Sant plans will come to fruition. The Haverfordwest issues are still in the melting pot.

Clerk to send a letter to The Valley regarding the street lights in Barham Road as the ones by the speed bumps are not working.
