Owen Duggan, Chairman and Nigel Davies, President from Fishguard Sports AFC attended the meeting to discuss their request for a donation. They are trying to get funding to get electricity to their site at Tregroes. They need £14,000 and have so far raised £11,500. They have had separate grant funding of £61,000 towards the pitch and have spent £88,000 in total. It is the only football club in the county with no electricity. They use a generator at present but it is heavy and gives off fumes. They have the largest number of teams in the county and also the most diverse. They cannot get match funding because they aren't a registered charity.
